

Directions to the Guild 'Care and Consideration' Seminar to be held at the National Railway Museum (NRM) Conference Centre on Saturday 5th November 2016.

By rail

The Museum is only a few minutes' walk from York station and the route is signposted:

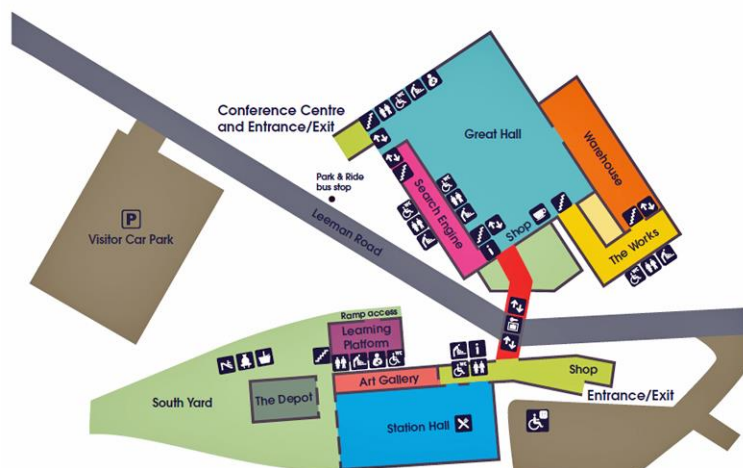
Turn left outside the front of the station

Pass the Royal York Hotel and turn left into Leeman Road

Continue through the tunnel; don't go to City Entrance on left hand side.

Keep right and continue up Leeman Road, the Museum conference centre is straight ahead on the right hand side.

There is also a direct route to the Museum via the station footbridge (not suitable for wheelchairs or pushchairs). This brings you out at the museum entrance; however we are using the Conference Centre entrance, so continue up Leeman Road for 0.2 mile:



By bus

Coming in from the A64 junction of the A1(M) then the Askham Bar Park and Ride drops off outside the Station - not the museum though.

The Rawcliffe Park & Ride bus picks up and drops off just outside the Museum.

By car

The postcode for your **SatNav** is: **YO26 4XJ**

This will take you to the NRM Conference Centre car park entrance on the south side of Leeman Road, opposite a car wash facility, from where you will have a short walk across Leeman Road to the seminar venue.



The Museum is clearly signposted from all approaches to the city. The visitor car park we are to use is on Leeman Road and across the road from the seminar venue in the NRM Conference Rooms. **Yes, it says £9 for the day but parking is included for our seminar delegates and an exit code is prominently displayed in the conference area.** If driving from York city centre, do not use the NRM 'City Entrance'.

From the A1(M) junction for A59 to York:

Take the A59 to York (New Road)

Drive to NRM in Leeman Rd in York - this should take 19 minutes without traffic.

Head east towards New Rd/A59 and continue on A59 for 11.6 miles (16 minutes)



Turn left onto Water End and continue for 0.3 mile



Turn right onto Salisbury Road



Continue on Salisbury Road for 0.1 mile



Continue onto Salisbury Terrace (one-way street) for 0.1 mile



Turn right onto Kingsland Terrace and continue for 0.1 mile



Kingsland Terrace turns left and becomes Leeman Road. Go under low railway bridge and continue for 0.4 mile.



NRM car park is on the right opposite the car wash.



From the car park, cross the road and the NRM Conference Centre entrance is facing you.
